The prizes

- 15 photos will be shortlisted and printed in the official Discover Bowland guide 2025 and will be announced via our web and social media channels
- From the shortlist, 3 will be selected in each category to receive the following prizes, kindly donated by members of the Forest of Bowland Sustainable Tourism Network:
 - o People: Family day pass from the Bowland Wild Boar Park
 - o Place: A night in a shepherd's hut (2 people) from Bowland Escapes
 - o Nature: £200 James' Places gift voucher donated Ben Scott Contracting Ltd (voucher expires 04.01.25)
- Note: The Forest of Bowland National Landscape team reserve the right to transfer prizes between categories if there are not enough shortlisted photos in one of the categories
- There will also be a People's Choice Award via an online public vote from the shortlist of photos across the categories. The winner will receive a £200 James' Places gift voucher kindly donated by Ben Scott Contracting Ltd.

Key dates

- The competition will run from **9am on 1st August to 9am on 30th September 2024**
- Shortlisting will take place between 1st and 2nd October
- The prize winners and all shortlisted entrants will be notified before 4th October
- Prize winners and the shortlist of 15 will be announced mid October
- The public vote will run for 1 week during October (dates tbc)

How will the winners be chosen?

A panel of judges will shortlist images based on composition, originality, and technical skill. A shortlisting panel will be made up of selected Forest of Bowland National Landscape staff and a member of the Bowland Sustainable Tourism Business Network. The prize-winning images will be judged by an external judge.

All three photos can be entered into one category, or split across the three categories, but must not be duplicated.
