Fungi perform an essential role in the decomposition of organic matter and are arguably some of the largest organisms on our planet. Irene is an expert on them having lectured and written extensively on ecology, plants and fungi.

Fungi are used as food (a whole variety of mushrooms and truffles) and yeast is used to make bread rise and to ferment wine and beer. Fungi are widely used in industry, not least for the production of antibiotics. They can be weird and wonderful - and where would we be without them? I am sure you will enjoy her talk!
